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PLAINTIFF'S MOTION TO COMPEL DEPOSITION OF DEFENDANT

Plaintiff requests this Honorable Court to compel the deposition of Defendant Breanna L DuBorgel and avers as follows.

- Plaintiff Philip Godlewski ("Godlewski") filed his complaint against the Defendant on or about March 27, 2023.
- Godlewski contends that Breanna DuBorgel (Defendant) defamed him by testifying, under oath, in an affidavit, that Plaintiff had sex with her numerous times when she was a minor. See complaint 7-9.
- 3. Godlewski also filed counts for invasion of privacy (false light) and invasion of privacy and publicity to private life.
- 4. Defendant counterclaimed for defamation, false light, assault, battery, intentional infliction of emotional distress, and negligent infliction of emotional distress.
- Defendant is a crucial witness in the related case of Godlewski v. Scranton Times, No.2021-CV-2195 also before this court.

- 6. In that case, Godlewski contends that Scranton Times defamed him when they wrote that he had had sexual relations with a minor (Breanna L DuBorgel).
- 7. Discovery in that case has been extended for the sole purpose of taking Ms. DuBorgel's deposition.
- 8. Plaintiff has attempted to get dates for Ms. DuBorgel's deposition before January 14, 2024, when Plaintiff's extension to take Ms. DuBorgel's deposition ends.
- 9. Plaintiff has every reason to believe that the Defendants in both cases are trying to run Plaintiff out of time because there has been consistent, ongoing delay and obstruction in scheduling Ms. DuBorgel's deposition, which is why the Plaintiff is filing this Motion to Compel.
- 10. Specifically, in an email dated Wednesday, December 27, 2023, Plaintiff's counsel proposed several dates for Defendant's deposition.
- 11. The following afternoon, counsel for Defendant responded that she was unavailable on any of the proposed dates and would speak to Defendant and "get back to" Plaintiff's counsel.
- 12. Despite advising of unavailability, Defendant's counsel did not advise when she would be available, nor did she propose alternative dates.
- 13. A true and correct copy of the complete e-mail exchange has been attached and incorporated as Exhibit 1.
- 14. In a follow-up e-mail dated January 3, 2024, counsel for Plaintiff inquired about the status of Defendant's availability and notified Defendant that the appropriate course of action would be assumed for failure to cooperate.
- 15. Shortly thereafter, the Defendant's counsel responded in an evasive manner, once again without providing alternative dates and only providing availability for depositions in this

instant action. A true and correct copy of said e-mail exchange has been attached and incorporated as Exhibit 2.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff Phillip Godlewski respectfully requests this Honorable Court to enter an order in the form attached, compelling Defendant Breanna DuBorgel to present herself for a deposition within ten days.

Hello Sarra. As you can see, I responded that I am not available on the dates you provided, and no additional dates were provided.
