**ORDER**

AND NOW, this 20<sup>th</sup> day of FEBRUARY, 2024, it is hereby

**ORDERED** the Motion for Stay of Wealth Discovery and Imposition of Restrictions filed by Plaintiff, Phillip Godlewski, is **GRANTED** in part and **DENIED** in part as follows:

- (1) As the Motion to Permit Asset Interrogatories and Requests for Production of Documents filed by Defendant, Brianna L. DuBorgel, was unopposed by Plaintiff and thus resulted in the entry by this Court of our Order dated September 25, 2023, permitting leave of court to conduct wealth discovery as allowed by Rule 4003.7 of the Pennsylvania Rules of Civil Procedure, Pa. R. C.P. 4003.7, Plaintiff's motion is **DENIED**;
- (2) As Rule 4003.7 requires the imposition of appropriate restrictions as to the time and scope of discovery and the dissemination of the material discovered, Plaintiff's motion is **GRANTED** as follows:
  - (a) To the extent discovery is sought for a temporal period, the look back is limited to the two (2) years which precede the date on which the discovery was propounded;

- (b) To the extent discovery seeks information concerning Plaintiff's wealth, the term "wealth" is revised to more accurately seek Plaintiff's "net worth," thereby allowing for the consideration of Plaintiff's liabilities as well as gross income or assets;
- (c) To the extent net worth discovery is produced, it shall be made subject to a protective order limiting dissemination of this highly sensitive information to counsel, counsel's immediate staff, and a potential expert witness; and
- (3) Subject to the restrictions set forth above in paragraph (2)(a) – (c), Plaintiff is directed to provide answers to the net worth discovery propounded upon him within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.
